Terms and Conditions

- Must be a current Utilities District of Western Indiana REMC residential member-consumer.
 - The applicant's primary address is identified on the application.
 - Rebates apply to push or self-propelled lawnmowers (does not include riding mowers), leaf blowers, and string trimmers only (corded or battery equipment is eligible).
 - Rebate does not apply to equipment combo packs.
 - Equipment must be purchased new; reconditioned or refurbished equipment is not eligible.
 - Rebates for qualifying equipment are the lesser of \$50 or 50% of purchase price.
 - Limit (1) rebate per member account.
 - Customer must complete and submit application to Utilities District of Western Indiana REMC.
 - Proof of purchase required (receipt or paid invoice).
 - Completed rebate application and documentation must be received within 90 days of purchase date.
 - Equipment must be purchased between January 1 and December 31, 2021.
 - Equipment must have a minimum one-year warranty.
 - Lawnmowers must have a minimum of 36 volts.
 - Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available.
 - Rebates may take up to 6 weeks from receipt of the application by Utilities District of Western Indiana REMC to process.
